SAFETY RECALL

Central Hydraulics High Position Motorcycle Lift Item # 99887

For certain units of the High Position Motorcycle Lift (Item # 99887), the welds may be susceptible to fatigue cracking. Further, the tubing quality for certain units may be insufficient to repeatedly lift the rated load. The inconsistent weld quality and/or inconsistent tubing may cause the product to fall and/or drop the load, posing a risk of injury and/or property damage.

IMMEDIATELY STOP USING THE HIGH POSITION MOTORCYCLE LIFT. DO NOT ATTEMPT TO REPAIR THE PRODUCT. Affected units were sold between October 6, 2008, and February 23, 2023. The High Position Motorcycle Lift subject to this recall can be identified by checking the item number (99887) found on the item or the packaging.



DO NOT RETURN THE ENTIRE PRODUCT TO THE STORE. To receive a refund in the form of an HFT gift card, carefully remove the Hydraulic Ram (pictured below) from the Motorcycle Lift according to the instructions below and return that part to the store.



Instructions to Remove the Hydraulic Ram

WARNING! To prevent serious injury: Release any load from the Motorcycle Lift before removing the Hydraulic Ram. Wear ANSI-approved safety goggles, heavy-duty work gloves, and safety shoes while removing the Hydraulic Ram.

Required tools from previous product assembly:

• Adjustable or 13mm wrench (x2); and

• Snap ring pliers or needle nose pliers.

1) Lower the Lift and remove any load.	
 2) Close the Release Valve and remove the bolts on the Hydraulic Ram Bracket using adjustable or 13mm wrenches. Remove the Clip Ring using snap ring pliers, then support the Hydraulic Ram while removing the Shaft. 	Shaft Clip Ring Bolt Bolt
 Return the Hydraulic Ram to your local Harbor Freight store for an HFT gift card. 	
 Recycle the rest of the unit or dispose of it properly
